- 1. The period for filing affidavits of candidacy for the office of school board member of Independent School District No. 252 shall begin on August 2, 2022, and shall close on August 16, 2022. An affidavit of candidacy must be filed in the office of the school district clerk and the \$2 filing fee paid prior to 5:00 o'clock p.m. on August 16, 2022.
- 2. The clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said filing dates to be published in the official newspaper of the district, at least two (2) weeks prior to the first day to file affidavits of candidacy. Publication of said notice prior to the date of adoption of this resolution is hereby ratified and approved in all respects.
- 3. The clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said filing dates to be posted at the administrative offices of the school district at least ten (10) days prior to the first day to file affidavits of candidacy.

The general election shall be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. At that election, three (3) members will be elected to the School Board for terms of four (4) years each. A special election will be held in conjunction with the general election. At that special election, one individual will be elected to fill a vacancy in term expiring January 6, 2025.

Affidavits of Candidacy are available from the school district clerk, 820 East Minnesota Street, Cannon Falls, MN 55009. The filing fee for this office is \$2. A candidate for this office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or more on assuming office, must have been a resident of the school district from which the candidate seeks election for thirty (30) days before the general and special election, and must have no other affidavit on file for any other office at the same primary or general election.
